Student Task Statement

Tyler and Clare want to know how many pets they have together. Tyler has 2 turtles. Clare has 4 dogs.

Tyler wrote the equation $4 + 2 = \lfloor 6 \rfloor$. Clare wrote the equation 2 + 4 = 6.
