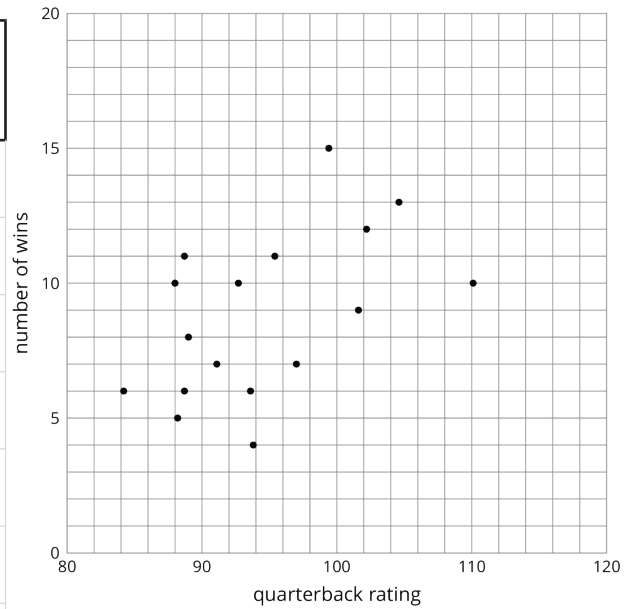


Lesson 3: What a Point in a Scatter Plot Means
